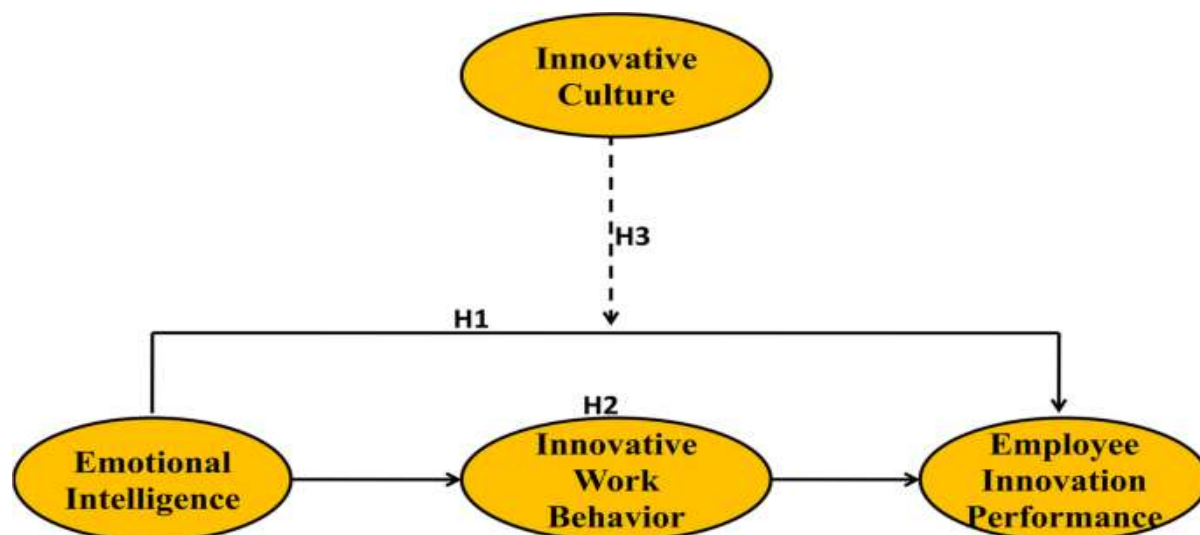
Introduction

Limitations:

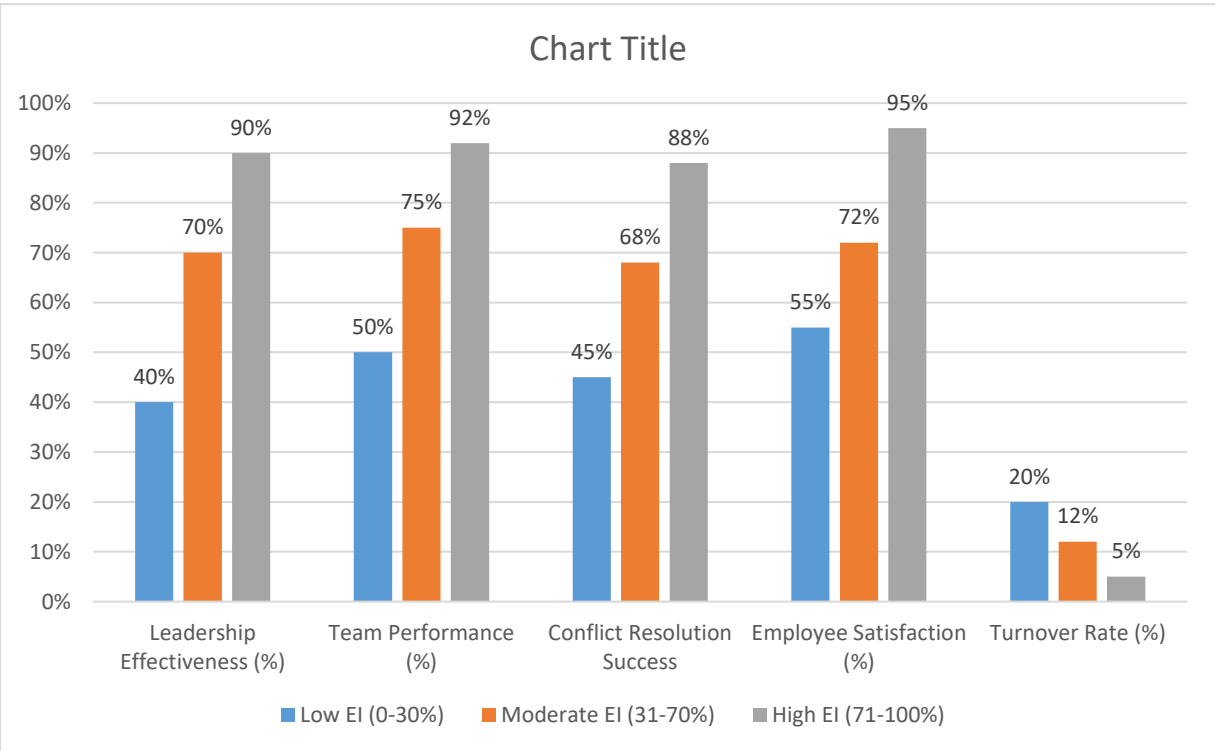
